#### Day 1: Arrival in Tehran

Welcome to Iran, the country of ancient history and deep-rooted culture! Meet and greet with your tour guide at **Imam Khomeini Airport**. Visit some attractions in Tehran depending on your flight time (check-in to the hotel from 2 PM).

Overnight: Tehran

### Day 2: Tehran- Shiraz (domestic flight)

Today, tour the bests that Tehran has to offer:

- ✓ Golestan Palace (UNESCO): A 16th-century royal palace with stunning tilework, gardens, and architecture.
- ✓ National Museum of Iran: showcasing ancient Iranian artifacts from over 5,000 years ago.
- ✓ Abgineh Museum: A museum with glass and pottery as old as 3rd century BCE.
- ✓ Grand Bazaar of Tehran: a vibrant market where you can mingle with the people and find local goods.

Evening flight to Shiraz.

Overnight: Shiraz

## Day 3: Shiraz

Tour the city of poets, orange gardens, and hospitable people:

- ✓ **Nasir-al-Molk Mosque** (also known as the Pink Mosque): Built in the 19th century, famous for vibrant stained glass and intricate tilework.
- ✓ Narenjestan Qavam House: A 19<sup>th</sup>-century mansion surrounded by lush orange gardens, featuring dazzling Iranian arts.
- ✓ **Tomb of Hafez:** A memorial to one of Iran's most revered poets, set in beautiful gardens.
- ✓ Eram Garden (UNESCO Persian Garden): a tranquil botanical garden of special Persian engineering and historical value.
- ✓ **Karim Khan Citadel**: A charming 18<sup>th</sup>-century fortress and palace from the Zand dynasty.
- ✓ Vakil Bazaar: A lively 18th-century market that features local lifestyle, traditional architecture, carpets, handicrafts, and spices.
- ✓ Ali-Ibn Hamzeh Mausoleum: A religious site of dazzling mirrored interior and peaceful ambiance.

Overnight: Shiraz

#### Day 4: Shiraz- Yazd

Road Trip from Shiraz to **Yazd** (around 440 km). On the way, stop by two of Iran's most precious sites:

✓ **Persepolis** (UNESCO): the remains of the 2,500-year-old palaces of the ancient ceremonial capital of Persia, now one of Iran's most treasured attractions.

✓ **Naqshe Rostam Necropolis**: A 2,500-year-old burial site for Achaemenid kings, with impressive rock-cut tombs.

In the evening you will arrive in Yazd. At night, you can take a pleasant walk in:

✓ Old Neighborhood of Yazd (UNESCO): also known as Fahadan Neighborhood, a historical district featuring mudbrick alleys and traditional desert architecture.

Overnight: Yazd

#### Day 5: Yazd

Visit the city of amazing desert architecture and Zoroastrian relics:

- ✓ Fire temple of Yazd: A Zoroastrian temple that houses a sacred flame that has been burning for over 1,500 years.
- ✓ Amirchakhmaq Complex: A 15th-century plaza with mosques and other interesting buildings in Yazd's historical center.
- ✓ **Dowlatabad Garden** (UNESCO Persian Garden): A historical garden known for its unique wind tower and peaceful ambiance.

In the afternoon, head to **Shabahang Dessert** to enjoy the incredible peace and beauty of the desert. Have a delicious dinner there. Finally, return to Yazd to spend the night. Overnight: Yazd

#### Day 6: Yazd- Isfahan

Road trip from Yazd to Isfahan (around 320 km). In Isfahan, visit:

- ✓ Armenian Neighborhood (Jolfa): a district of a nice atmosphere that showcases cafes, Armenian culture, and churches.
- ✓ Vank Cathedral: this 17<sup>th</sup>-century Armenian church blends Persian and Christian architectural styles.
- ✓ Si-O-Se Pol Bridge: A beautiful 17th-century bridge with 33 arches, spanning the river that runs in the middle of Isfahan.

Overnight: Isfahan

#### Day 7: Isfahan

The hub of Iran's Islamic masterpieces expects you at:

- ✓ Naqsh-e Jahan Square: Shah Mosque, Sheikh Lotfolllah Mosque, Ali Qapu Palace, and traditional Bazaar: a 16<sup>th</sup>-century complex that's the climax of Islamic architecture in Iran.
- ✓ Chehel Sotoun Palace (UNESCO Persian Garden): A 17th-century palace with frescoes, reflecting pools, and beautiful gardens.

Overnight: Isfahan

#### Day 8: Isfahan- Abyaneh- Tehran

Road trip from Isfahan to **Imam Khomeini International Airport** (around 400 km) to catch a flight back home. On the way, stop by:

✓ Abyaneh Village (also known as Red Village): a historical village of over 1,000 years old, known for its red adobe houses.
